



# Pathways to Graduation

Students today have several options to ensure everyone can achieve graduation, even if it's not the traditional path. Student choose one of the following pathways:

## KEYSTONE PROFICIENCY

Score Proficient or Advanced on each Keystone exam.

## KEYSTONE COMPOSITE

Score Proficient or Advanced on at least one Keystone Exam, no scores Below Basic, and a Composite score of at least 2939.

## CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Attain, or be scheduled to attain, an Industry Based Certification, or continued engagement in thier program of study (Like higher education)

## ALTERNATIVE ASSESSMENT

Meet a specific score in an alternate assessment, such as the ASVAB, ACT/WorkKeys, SAT/PSAT, an AP Exam, or an approved Pre-Apprenticeship.

## EVIDENCE- BASED

Use a combination of evidence, such as a Proficient or Advanced Score on a Keystone Exam, a job shadow or internship, certification of full-time employment or military enlistment.
